Kraków, formerly the capital of Poland, is a historical city. It is famous for its cultural traditions and historical monuments such as the Royal Wawel Castle, the Main Market Square, St. Mary's Basilica with its famous altar, the Jagiellonian University where Copernicus studied, and Kazimierz – the historic Jewish quarter. The famous Wieliczka Salt Mine, almost 1000 years old, is 12km away from the Market Square.

There are daily flights to Kraków from Chicago, Copenhagen, Frankfurt, London, Paris, Rome, Vienna, Warsaw and Zurich.

WORKSHOP PROGRAM
